The University of Ghana Collaborative on Climate Resilience and Sustainability (UG-CCReS) project is a climate change research and capacity-building initiative aimed at empowering young people, especially women, refugees/displaced youth, and youth with disabilities, in West Africa to conduct cutting-edge research, lead climate-resilient development, and foster green economic growth.

As part of its commitment to empowering young people, UG-CCReS is inviting applications for prospective national service persons for the 2025/2026 academic year to contribute to the work of the project while gaining valuable hands-on experience.

We welcome applications from final year undergraduate students from universities in Ghana with academic backgrounds or skill sets in the following areas:

- \*Additional skills such as graphic design, website/social media content creation, and communications are an added advantage.

Applicants should also demonstrate:

- 1. Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
- 2. Strong organisational and communication skills.
- 3. Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a team environment.
- 4. A genuine interest in climate change and sustainability.

- 2. Academic transcript
- 3. Current CV
