MP FOR AYAWASO WEST WUOGON MAKES DONATION TO AUGMENT UNIVERSITY SECURITY EFFORTS

The Member of Parliament (MP) for Ayawaso West Wuogon Constituency, Hon. Lydia Seyram Alhassan, as part of efforts to enhance security on campus, has donated two motor bikes and a saloon car to the University.

In brief remarks, Hon. Alhassan said she had to cut short her trip when she heard of the assault case involving a student of the university in order to call on management, and also to look for ways in which she could be of assistance as the MP for the area. She indicated that the motive for the gesture was to help increase security visibility and enhance security patrols on campus so as to create a conducive and safe environment for students and members of the University community.

The victim, a level 400 student is currently on admission at the 37 Military Hospital. A team of University officials led by the Vice-Chancellor and representatives from the student leadership have visited him at the hospital. He is stable and responding to treatment.

Ministry of Energy Donates Electrical Items to the University of Ghana

The Ministry of Energy has donated electrical items to the University of Ghana to assist in the management of the demand-side programme of power consumption. This follows a meeting held between the Vice-Chancellor, the Independent Power Supply Team under the Vice-Chancellor's Strategic Team, and the Ministry Energy.

The items were presented to the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Kwame Offei by the Contractor, Messrs Johome Company Limited who have been assigned to undertake the installation by the Ministry of Energy. The items are 1,000 Pieces of 150 Watts LED Street Lights, 2,000 Pieces of M16 x 280 Nuts and Washers and 254 Angle Bars. The Pro-Vice Chancellor, who received the items on behalf of the Vice Chancellor thanked the government for the donation.

IESS RECEIVES LABORATORY EQUIPMENT FROM ST. CLOUD STATE UNIVERSITY

The Institute for Environment and Sanitation Studies (IESS) has received a set of sampling and laboratory equipment from the St. Cloud State University's Aquatic Toxicology Laboratory and the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis through the efforts of Prof. Heiko Schoenfuss and Prof. Paige Novak.

The equipment which included an Ekman grab, mini water pumps, centrifuge, data loggers and laboratory consumables valued at about USD 10,000, were officially handed over to the Ecological Laboratory (EcoLab) of the IESS in a brief ceremony on Thursday, May 2, 2019. The donation follows the completion of the first phase of a collaborative research project between the US project partners and IESS themed 'Improving the Sustainability of Aquaculture in Ghana through Environmental Quality Assessment'.
